

## Fall 2004 transition to Spring 2005

---

**Super II** teams from Fall 2004 had 2 options for Spring 2005

1. Participate in the Cup competition designated by STYSA for SII – Presidents Cup – and pay \$150 to WD
2. For those desiring a “higher” level of competition they could finish in the top of Fall 2004 and participate in the next higher Cup competition designated by STYSA - National Cup – and pay \$900 to WDDOA. The following SII teams chose this option -

Following the Spring 2005 season the teams who sought DI status, either from SII or having failed qualification from DI, could attempt to qualify in the WDDOA DI qualifier during Summer 2005. This qualification was available in those age groups where “slots” were created from teams folding, falling below 50%+1 or where the group was already below the planned size. This QT cost \$500 per team.

---

**Division I** Teams from Fall 2004 had 2 options for Spring 2005

1. Participate in the Cup competition designated by STYSA for DI – National Cup – in the format defined in the WDDOA System of Play – 2 flights across 2 rounds of advancement.
2. If the team had a poor record for Fall 2004 and desired a “lower” level of competition they were permitted to participate in the Presidents Cup on an exception basis.

The lowest finishing teams in the second flight of National Cup were no longer classified as DI and required to attempt to qualify in the Summer 2005 QT if “slots” became available.

Two teams advanced to State Playoffs from each age group with the chance to advance to Regionals representing WD.

## Fall 2005 transition to Spring 2006

---

**Super II** teams from Fall 2005 have 3 options for Spring 2006

1. Participate in the Cup competition designated by STYSA for SII – Directors Cup – and pay \$150 to WD
2. For those desiring a “higher” level of competition from any position finish in their group for Fall 2005 can participate in the next higher Cup competition designated by STYSA - Presidents Cup – and pay \$650 to WDDOA.
3. For those desiring the “highest” level of competition from any finish in their group for Fall 2005 can participate in the highest Cup competition designated by STYSA – National Cup – and pay \$500 to WDDOA for the “play-in” games. Once through the team would then pay an additional \$750 for the remaining portion of the National Cup competition.

Following the Spring 2006 season the teams who will seek DI status, either from SII or having failed qualification from Presidents Cup, could attempt to qualify in the WDDOA DI qualifier during Summer 2006. This qualification will only be available in those age groups where “slots” are created from teams folding, falling below 50%+1 or where the group was already below the planned size. This QT will cost \$500 per team.

---

**Division I** Teams from Fall 2005 have 2 options for Spring 2006

1. Participate in the highest level of Cup competition designated by STYSA for DI – National Cup – if they finished in the top 6 positions of Fall 2005 league play. If the finish was below 6 then they can apply for the “play-in” games and pay \$500 to WDDOA.
2. Participate in the second level of Cup competition designated by STYSA for DI – Presidents Cup – if they finished below the top 6 positions of Fall 2005 league play.

The lowest finishing teams in the second flight of DI – Presidents Cup – will no longer be classified as DI and required to attempt to qualify in the Summer 2005 QT if “slots” became available.

Two teams will have the opportunity to advance to State Playoffs from each age group in each of National and Presidents Cup with the chance to advance to Regionals representing WD.
